

### 1. Check-worthiness

Transformers. GPT-3, \*BERT, AraBERT, XLM-RoBERTa

Multimodality: Vision Transformer, CLIP, Ensemble (Text: BERT,

Image: VGG, ResNet, EfficientNet)

### **Check-worthiness in Multimodal and Multigenre Content**

**1A (Multimodal):** Assess whether a tweet —including both text and image—is check-worthy

**1B (Multigenre):** Assess whether a text snippet alone —from a tweet or a debate/interview/speech transcription— is check-worthy

### **Check-Worthiness in Multimodal and Multigenre Content**

**1A (Multimodal):** Assess whether a tweet —including both text and image—is check-worthy



The Malaysian Ministry of Education has introduced E-Skrol, an application built on the NEM blockchain to deal with the issue of certificate fraud through the use of blockchain technology.

(a) Checkworthy



Turns out I've been doing airborne precautions wrong my whole life. #coronavirus

(b) Not-checkworthy

**1B (Multigenre):** Assess whether a text snippet alone —from a tweet or a debate/interview/speech transcription— is check-worthy
